Award Criteria:

- 1. Applicant must be a **female high school senior in Pike County** preparing to attend a college or university in the State of Alabama.
- 2. Applicant must be a citizen of the United States.
- 3. Applicant must have at least a 3.3 GPA on a 4.0 scale.
- 4. Applicant must have volunteered in community service activities.
- 5. Applicant must have participated in extracurricular activities which exhibit leadership skills/abilities.

Application Process:

Applicant must submit the following items:

- Completed application form (if handwritten, please print legibly).
- Two (2) character references in the form of a letter of recommendation in sealed envelopes.
- A copy of the most recent transcript with cumulative grade point average.
- Proof of acceptance to the college/university you plan to attend in the Fall 2021.
- Personal Essay. (Section C on application)
