



CACF scholarship only for graduating seniors of Pike County schools:

Dr. James H. French Memorial Scholarship

The Dr. James H. French Scholarship is awarded to a graduating senior of any school in Pike County, based upon the student's academic achievement, school and community involvement, and financial need. Preference is given to students showing a proficiency in accelerated math and science coursework. A minimum 3.5 GPA and ACT score of 23 are required. One scholarship ranging from \$1,000 to \$2,000 will be awarded.

Other CACF scholarships for which Coffee County students may be eligible:

Jay Murphy Scholarship

The Jay Murphy Scholarship benefits students who have the desire to become teachers and who relate well with young people. Applicants may include those who are entering or continuing college, individuals who are in education and want to upgrade their skills, or individuals who wish to return to college to become teachers. One scholarship is awarded with the amount determined annually.

Jerry L. Bartley Memorial Scholarship

The Jerry L. Bartley Memorial Scholarship is a new award that benefits high school graduates who are active AAU basketball players and emulate the profound love, passion, and commitment to the game of basketball that Jerry Bartley had throughout his life. An eligible applicant will reside in the state of Alabama, meet the academic initial-eligibility standards for NCAA Division I athletes, and be an active AAU basketball player. The amount and number of awards are determined annually, and this year's application deadline will be March 15.

Todd Webb Scholarship

The Todd Webb Scholarship is available to graduates of any high school located in Alabama who will attend the University of Alabama and study in the College of Communication and Information Sciences. A focus on Sport Communication is preferred, but not required. One \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded.
