SCHOLARSHIPS DEADLINES FROM: MARCH 15 – MAY 15, 2021

1) Louie Family Foundation Scholarships - \$4,000 – 25 Awards (Deadline: March 15, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a freshman in the 2021-2022 academic year at a U.S. accredited college/university.
- B) Have a cumulative, un-weighted grade point average between 3.7 and 4.0.
- C) Have a minimum SAT score of 1300 (out of 1600) or a minimum ACT score of 27.

2) FEEA Scholarships - \$5,000 – 400 Awards (Deadline: March 25, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be children, step-children, or legal dependents of full- or part-time permanent federal civilian or postal workers employed with the federal government for more than three years.

3) No Essay YDI Scholarship - \$2,222 – 1 Award (Deadline: March 29, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a resident of any of the 50 United States, District of Columbia or US Territories.
- B) Be 16 years of age or older and be enrolled in college or registered in a high school.

4) NC Scholarships - \$2,000 - 12 Awards (Deadline: March 31, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be currently enrolled as a high school senior or a student enrolled at an accredited college or university located within the United States.

B) Have a GPA of at least 2.5.

5) SP High School Scholarship - \$10,000 - 10 Awards (Deadline: March 31, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a high school student planning to attend college in September 2021.

B) Answer the Essay question on the sponsors website.

6) American Nuclear Society Scholarship - \$5,000 - 3 Awards (Deadline: April 1, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a high school senior who has enrolled full-time in college courses pursuing science, technology, engineering, or mathematics (STEM) with an interest in working in nuclear science and technology.

7) Lockheed Martin STEM Scholarship - \$10,000 - 200 Awards (Deadline: April 1, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be a High School senior with a 2.5 or above GPA.

B) Be enrolling in one of the following majors: Aerospace Engineering, Computer Engineering, Computer Science, Electrical Engineering, Industrial Engineering, Mechanical Engineering or Physics.

8) Young Women in Public Affairs Award - \$4,000 - 42 Awards (Deadline: April 1, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a women, ages 16-19 on April 1, living in a Zonta district/region.
- B) Demonstrate evidence of at least one of the following: Active commitment to volunteerism, Experience in local government, student government, or workplace leadership.

9) Heavy Equipment Parts Express Scholarship - \$500 – 1 Award (Deadline: April 1, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Currently be in high school, college, or university.
- B) Be at least 16 years of age on the day of the deadline.

10) Scott and Kim Verplank Foundation Scholarship - \$10,000 - 1 Award (Deadline: April 15, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

- A) Be a high school senior diagnosed with Type 1 Diabetes and have a GPA of 3.0 or greater.
- B) Be successfully managing diabetes with proper medication, exercise and diet.

13) VSA Emerging Young Artists Program - \$20,000 - 15 Awards (Deadline: April 28, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Be between the ages of 16 and 25 during the application window and have a disability as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act. This includes sensory, physical, cognitive, learning, socio-emotional disabilities and more.
